Show Me The Mission

We want our witness to be positive, and it will likely have more power if it's covert and subtle rather than zealous and verbal. If we walk through the Bible to learn patterns of how God operates, we will discover that He has always been in the business of sending out spies and warriors. Our battles are of a different nature than those His followers in ancient times faced, but they involve warfare nonetheless. And our warfare demands different approaches today. We dress up in a suit and go to work where devils dress up in suits as well. We don't even have different uniforms. So if God wants to subdue some enemies, perhaps some corruptions to be exposed, He will select a good faithful Christian who understands "undercover work."

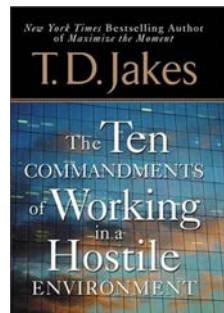
In our modern world, God sees the injustice, prejudice, racism, fraud, embezzlement, and all the forms of harassment that exist and grow like cancer where innocent people work every day trying to earn a decent living. Doesn't it seem likely that a compassionate God who is "kind to all the works of His hands" would wince at all the injustice and feel compelled to intervene? So you, Christian, are on a mission.

There is no other motivator that can sustain you. It's not about the money; God could send checks in the mail arrange inheritances, endowments, or just stuff a few hundred-dollar bills in the laundry detergent box. However, I'm afraid that without a monetary reward system in place, there would be few people who would ever go to work. There is nothing wrong with money and everybody needs it, but receiving revenue should not be the Christian's primary reason for work.

For the Christian, a job is where God can get His work accomplished and pay His children to do it. If He wants them on the job full-time after they have been faithful part-time, God will arrange favor to surround them so that their boss "somehow" becomes aware of their faithfulness, maturity, promptness, and diligence.

One World Technologies Recalls Ryobi Cordless Tool Battery Pack Due to Fire and Burn Hazards

Consumers should stop using this product unless otherwise instructed. It is illegal to resell or attempt to resell a recalled consumer product.

Recall date: February 26, 2013

Recall number: 13-124

Name of product: Ryobi Lithium 18 V 4Ah Battery Pack

Hazard: The battery pack can overheat and burst while on a charger, posing fire and burn hazards to consumers.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately remove the battery from the charger, stop using the recalled battery pack and contact One World Technologies for instructions on the free shipping and repair of the recalled product.

"Ryobi" and "Lithium+18V" are printed in white lettering on both sides of the battery pack. The model and part number can be found on the data plate located on the bottom of the battery pack.

Incidents/Injuries: One World Technologies has received four reports of battery packs overheating, resulting in minor property damage. No injuries have been reported.

Sold at: The Home Depot stores nationwide and in Canada, online at Homedepot.com, and at other retailers from September 2012 to December 2012 for about \$99.
