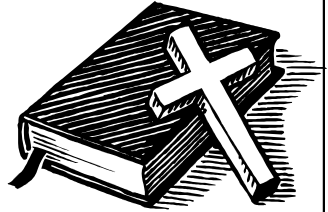

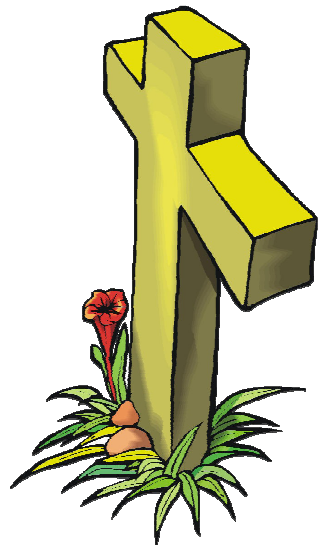

Vision Quest

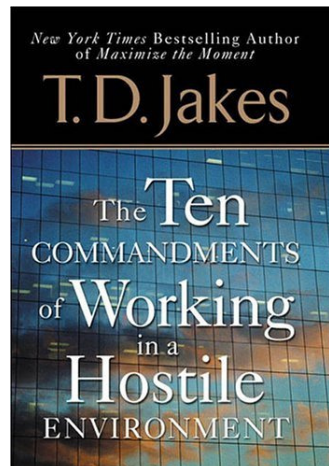
Even in the midst of doing your job well and being a magnetic witness for faith, you must cultivate a vision for where you are going. Scripture tells us that people perish without vision (Proverbs 29:18). You must be in pursuit of the hope and dreams that God has planted in you and are growing in you even as you water and nourish that seed in the soil of your present position.

Sometime it's easy to cultivate that vision and imagine your natural progression from your present employment all the way to the top of the industry.
