

# Feed the Need Elsewhere

How do you detach yourself from the superglue that cliques seem to used in order to attract and attach their members? Becoming vigilant is one of the best ways. Simply remaining aware of the warning signs and ways cliques operate can allow you to sidestep them and avoid becoming ensnared. It's difficult to avoid getting bogged down in quicksand if you gradually walk into it unaware. Suddenly your steps begin sinking before you even realize what's happened and then before long you're waistdeep in trouble. However if you pay attention to where you step and stype on the path of righteousness you will keep your momentum and reach your destination without delay. So separate yourself from situations and relationships that ay have created labels for you and placed you under obligation. It may take awhile and a few polite "no thank you not today" responses, but gradually you can be liberated.


Another way to avoid becoming ensnared in cliques is to make sure your relational needs are being met outside of the workplace. If you're starving for human connection and suddenly have opportunity to belong to a group of people who provide you with affirmation at work, you will be unlikely to resist. You must feed the need for friendship elsewhere. This is not to say that you shouldn't befriend coworkers or be pleasant and cordial with them. But you must not make this the place where you meet your primary needs for human relationship. You must remember that you are not at work to make friends and have a good time. If that happens as a by-product of performing your job then that's a gift. However, we should not expect it or work to cultivate it.

God created families and friends for social support. I believe we are most susceptible to cliques and groups when our rela-

tional need are not being met in appropriate ways elsewhere. Such a void in our lives can also set us up for office romances and illicit affairs. ...

## Product Recall - Class I

Rich Products Corporation, a Buffalo, NY firm, is recalling approximately 196,222 pounds of frozen chicken quesadilla and various other heat treated, not fully cooked frozen mini meals and snack items because they may be contaminated with E. coli O121, the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) announced today.

The following products are subject to FSIS recall:

4132235635 - Farm Rich - Appetizers - Mini Quesadillas - 18 OZ

4132235643 - Farm Rich Mini Pizza Slices with cheese pepperoni and sauce in pizza dough - 22  $\mbox{OZ}$ 

4132237443 - Farm Rich - Appetizers - Mozzarella Bites a pizzeria style crust - 22 OZ

Each product package above contains the establishment number "EST. 27232" or "P-27233" inside the USDA mark of inspection.

The products subject to recall were produced between Nov. 12, 2012 and Nov. 19, 2012 then distributed for retail sale nationwide. FSIS and the establishment are concerned that some product may be present in household freezers. "Best By" dates of January 1, 2013 through September 29, 2014. Sold in WalMart & Giant Foods.

FSIS was notified of a multistate investigation of E. coli O121 illnesses on March 19, 2013. Food samples were collected from an ill individual in New York as part of this investigation, and tested by the New York State Department of Health Wadsworth Laboratory. At present, the cluster includes 24 cases in 15 states. A sample of a Farm Rich frozen chicken mini quesadilla product from a New York case tested positive for the outbreak strain of E. coli O121. Eight cases in Michigan, Mississippi, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Texas, and Virginia report consuming Farm Rich products. FSIS is continuing to work with federal and state public health partners on this investigation, including the New York State Department of Health, New York State Department of Agriculture & Markets, Food and Drug Administration, and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
