**PennDOT Offers New Online Service  
for Duplicate Licenses, ID Cards**

Harrisburg – As part of PennDOT's commitment to enhanced customer service, customers can now order a duplicate non-commercial driver's license or photo identification card online if theirs is lost or stolen.

"Ordering a duplicate driver's license or photo identification card just got easier for our customers," PennDOT's Secretary Barry J. Schoch said. "This is another example of our online services saving customers time and providing the convenience of completing transactions from the comfort of home."

No additional fees are charged for online transactions. Customers applying for a duplicate license or photo ID card online must provide their driver's license or ID card number, last four digits of their Social Security number and date of birth in order to complete the transaction. A \$13.50 fee for the duplicate driver's license or photo ID card will be charged to the customer's credit card for the new product. The fee for a duplicate driver's license with a class M (motorcycle) is \$18.50.

Customers applying for a duplicate driver's license online can print a temporary Internet copy of their license to use until their new photo license arrives in the mail. The temporary license is valid for 15 days.

Driver and vehicle online services are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week and include driver's license, photo ID and vehicle registration renewals; driver-history services; changes of address; driver license and vehicle registration restoration letters; ability to pay driver license or vehicle insurance restoration fee; and driver exam scheduling.

## Choose Forgiveness, Not Gossip

***“Love prospers when a fault is forgiven, but dwelling on it separates close friends.”***

(Proverbs 17:9 NLT)

Let’s just admit it: When you have some crazy-maker in your life, and she’s just done the craziest thing *again*, it’s almost impossible not to get in the car, pull out your phone, and call somebody and say, “You won’t *believe* what she just did!”

Or, “You won’t *believe* what he just did!” In fact, you may even be texting as he’s doing it!

That’s what we do with crazy-makers. We want to tell somebody else. We want affirmation from somebody else. It’s the most difficult thing in the world to let go of it. It may feel good when we call someone to spread the word about the crazy-maker’s craziness, but it’s also unloving.

The Bible says to forgive even your enemies. Proverbs 17:9 says, “*Love prospers when a fault is forgiven, but dwelling on it separates close friends*” (NLT).

Gossip is incredibly destructive. It is destructive to churches, families, and businesses. It is destructive to your life. It tears you up. It separates the closest of friends.

The worst thing about gossip is that the crazy-maker wins! All of a sudden, your crazy-maker is *controlling* your conversation. The crazy-maker is controlling your emotions. Don’t let that person win! Don’t let the crazy-maker win by choosing gossip.

1 Peter 3:9 says, “*Do not do wrong to repay a wrong, and do not insult to repay an insult. But repay with a blessing, because you yourselves were called to do this so that you might receive a blessing*” (NCV).

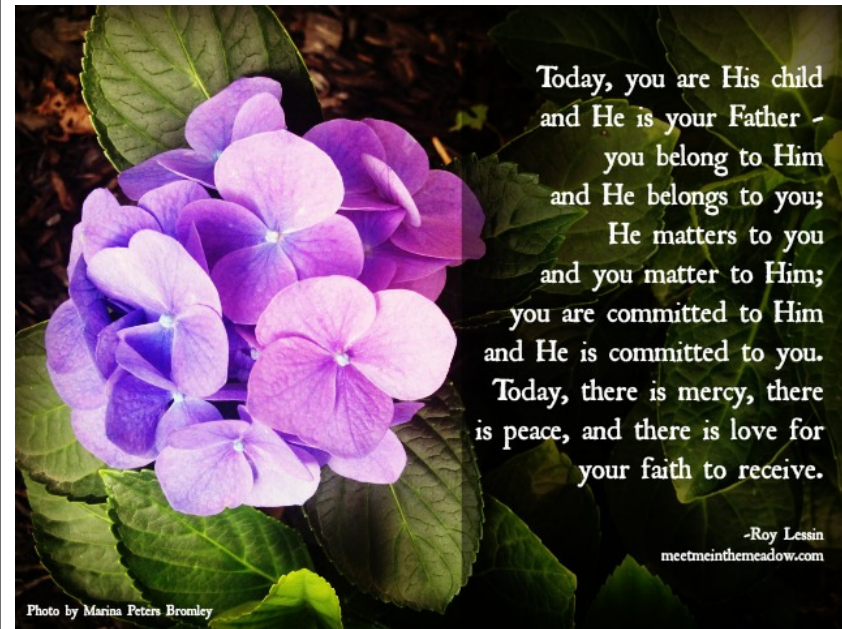


