
When those doubts come your way, don't get discouraged. Bring them in line with God's Word. It works every time!

Suicide... No Longer Taboo, but a Present Reality

Tuesday, August 26, 2014 7:30 to 8:45 pm Hosted by Greater Works Ministries

This seminar will address the all important role of leaders, pastors, religious educators, and others who work and interact with people, in helping individuals who experience hopelessness, helplessness, and despair that result in thoughts of harming self or taking one's own life. Statistics show that among younger generations, suicide is a growing trend and a leading cause of death. Consequently, it is becoming a growing issue in the religious context, while there is a lack of training among clergy on how to appropriately deal with such cases.
