

### Suicide... No Longer Taboo, but a Present Reality

### Tuesday, August 26, 2014 7:30 to 8:45 pm Hosted by Greater Works Ministries

This seminar will address the all important role of leaders, pastors, religious educators, and others who work and interact with people, in helping individuals who experience hopelessness, helplessness, and despair that result in thoughts of harming self or taking one's own life. Statistics show that among younger generations, suicide is a growing trend and a leading cause of death. Consequently, it is becoming a growing issue in the religious context, while there is a lack of training among clergy on how to appropriately deal with such cases. This workshop will highlight the importance of adequate and appropriate training of clergy and helping ministries, define and conceptualize mental illnesses that are highly correlated with suicidal ideation from a spiritual perspective, teach the basics of suicide risk assessment, and provide a basic protocol and resources to safeguard the ministry and ministry leaders from legal and ethical liabilities.

Dr. Rayvann Kee II is a clinical and organizational psychologist, entrepreneur, and minister of the gospel of Jesus Christ. He has traveled extensively preaching the kingdom of God and teaching biblical principles pertaining to God's desire for people spiritually, physically, psychologically, financially, professionally, and personally. He holds interests in executive assessment and coaching, servant-leadership development, minority mental health, spirituality and psychotherapy, and psychology in primary care. He serves as an associate minister, director of missions and outreach, director of men's ministry, and a Sunday school teacher at the Pentecostal Faith Assembly Church, under the leadership of Suffragan Bishop Brenda Cuthbertson.
